She creatively incorporates dance and movement to support artists who have a creative block or need to manage stress.

By fostering collaborations with other organizations, Kris has had EA artwork featured as the online playbill for Johnson Country Park and Recreation District's Theater in the Park productions and oversaw a short documentary film featuring the artists which has won multiple awards. She also coordinated the artists' attendance at multiple screenings of the film and helped facilitate a panel discussion which featured two of the artists as presenters.

During COVID, she had the idea for an online store to maintain art sales since no public shows were available. She set up a very successful online store which maintained sales and still flourishes today. The artists are able to access the store thanks to training Kris developed. Through an available grant, Kris had the vison to connect artists with art professionals in the community to talk and get feedback on their artwork. These professionals included an art professor, a gallery owner, and an art career development specialist. It was exciting to see how the artists engaged and how much they had in common. The artists in the EA program were inspired by these meetings.

Kris has submitted, had accepted, and sold various artists' artwork to regional gallery shows. Recently, she encouraged and supported several artists to participate in a show on their own. This August, three of the artists will be showing independent of JCDS Emerging Artists at an art show.
